LANGUAGES IN LISD

LISD TEACHES SPANISH, FRENCH, GERMAN, LATIN, JAPANESE, AND AMERICAN SIGN LANGUAGE (ASL) WITH UP TO SIX LEVELS OF COURSES TO GAIN LINGUISTIC COMPETENCY FOR EACH LANGUAGE. THE DISTRICT HAS MORE THAN 100 TEACHERS TEACHING WORLD LANGUAGES FOR K-12 STUDENTS.



SPANISH LANGUAGE

LISD IS ONE OF ONLY TWO SPANISH IMMERSION DISTRICTS FOR ELEMENTARY STUDENTS IN DFW. LISD ALSO OFFERS "DUAL LANGUAGE" COURSES AT 12 ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS FOR STUDENTS TO LEARN SPANISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE WITH STUDENTS WHO ARE LEARNING ENGLISH AS A SECOND LANGUAGE.

A SPECIALLY-DESIGNED, ADVANCED SPANISH LANGUAGE PROGRAM IS OFFERED IN 11 OF LISD'S MIDDLES SCHOOLS, WHERE MORE THAN 1000 STUDENTS ARE ENROLLED (WITH AN 87% SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION RATE)..
